Thanks for the email Alexis,

Here are my responses:

1) I can't fully comment on the completion date as there are many factors out of my hands, but I will work to make this completion date fit.

2) With the current deferred capital maintenance we have in the water and waste department I find it insulting that we pull funds from the department through a dividend. I would like to see the dividend dropped (or removed entirely) so we can retain some of our earnings in the department to get this, and the combined sewer projects, additional funds. As this dividend is scheduled to be reviewed within 3 months of the election, if I'm elected I will push to have it reduced from the current 11% down to 5%, which will leave an additional \$8 million per year in the Water and Waste department.

While this won't fully fund projects of this magnitude, it will allow for the City to have additional money for tri-level funding partnerships.

The eventual goal would be getting this dividend removed entirely, but will take some time.

3) Manitoba is known for its lake culture. Allowing the continued degradation of our waterways will destroy that culture. I have completed my "climate resilient communities" platform, with my dedication to our waterways -- while not specifically mentioning the lakes to our north, it shows I am committed to clean water. <https://votesnyder.ca/climate-resilient-communities/>
